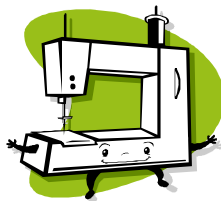

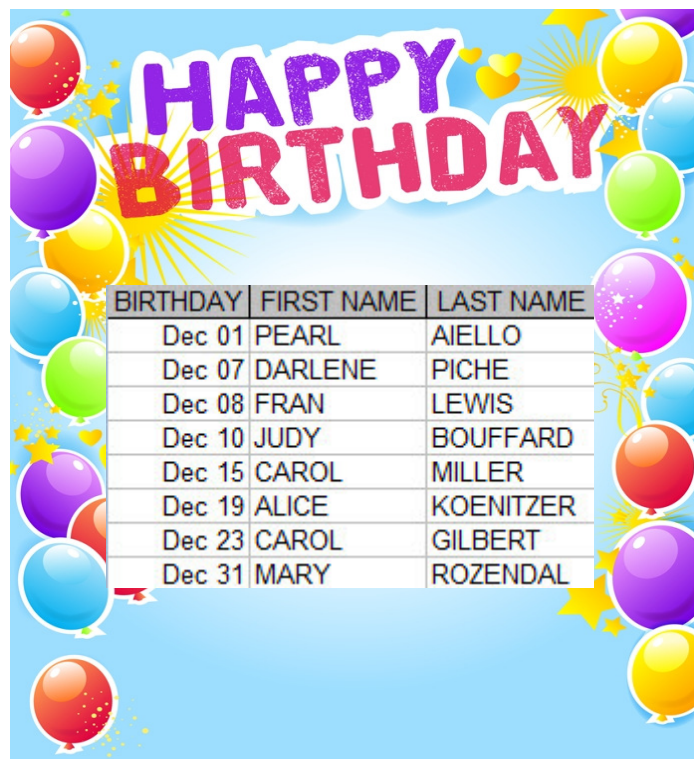

Philanthropy

In October, Peggy Castor introduced a new quilting project to the group. It is an isolette cover for the very tiny premature babies born at the UCSD hospital. The isolette cover keeps light from the baby, in an effort to recreate the dark environment of the womb. Peggy designed the 5-part pattern. Several pieces will be sew-and-flip strips. Other pieces require only quilting -- meandering or straight lines, or a design of your choice. After all the pieces are quilted they will be sewn together to create the complete isolette cover.

This month, Friendship Philanthropy gave 28 placemats and 4 wheel chair bags to Meals on Wheels. Two quilts went to St. Claire's Home. Four quilts went to Children's Rady Hospital. One quilt was donated to Quilts of Valor, and four wheel chair bags and one quilt went to Veteran's Hospital.

The completed items turned in during the November meeting included: more than 63 placemats. Of these, Chris Berg turned in 56 original placemats. All four isolette kits were checked out in October and we received seven kits back. One person took the pattern and created three more sections. We received several wheel chair bags and two completed quilts.

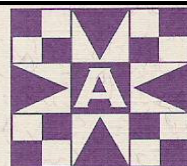

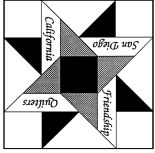
