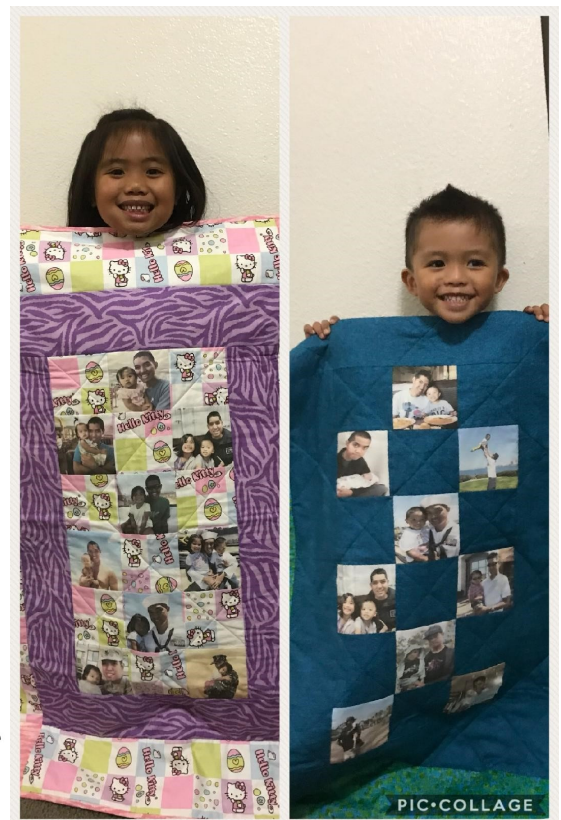
Hi Ruth,

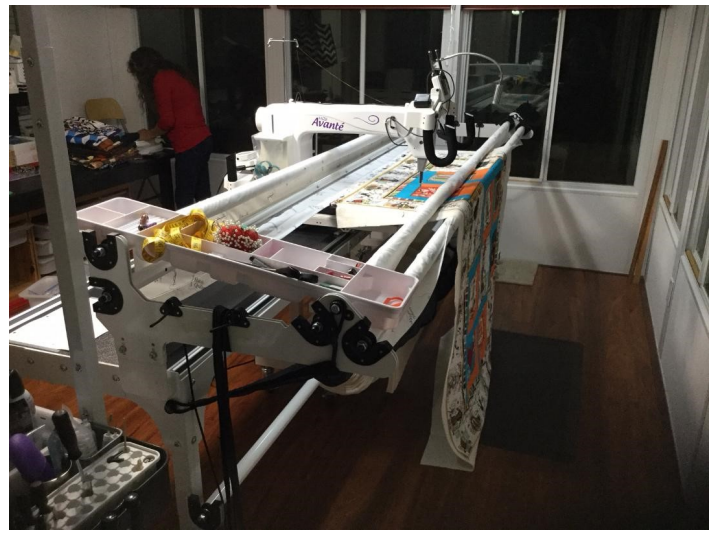

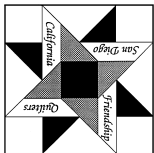
