Wow! here we are at the end of 2016 and the beginning of 2017.


We had a lovely evening at Karla's house on December 12. It was very festive being in a member's home with all the Christmas decorations and good food. Thanks to all who participated.



## **Programs**

KIM FAUTH will be teaching us her "ABCD Quilting" technique at a workshop on Sunday, January 8, and share 20 stunning examples of quilts that put the technique to use at our January 9, 2017 Friendship Quilters' guild meeting.

Kim has been teaching quilt classes for approximately ten years, but has been quilting for over 30. As a former math teacher she is an expert at explaining material so it makes sense. When she came up with the ABCD Technique, she shared it with her Monday quilting group and they strongly encouraged her to write a book because it was so new and different. Her teaching background is evident throughout the book. The directions are in white, gray and black, with areas of emphasis in blue. Each step is broken down with accurate drawings and hints to make sewing easier. Even though there are only three steps, she has a review page after Step Two so you don't ruin all your gorgeous fabric. You will also see her fun personality throughout the pages and when she is teaching/lecturing.

Kim promises you can make 32 blocks for this quilt in three hours and then spend the rest of your day (or less) arranging them into layouts that only LOOK complicated. So, start the new year right, with a quick and simple quilt to get your creativity flowing. Treat yourself to this low-intensity, fun workshop and then come back on Monday evening to enjoy Kim's presentation at our January guild meeting.
