The Salvation Army recycles all textiles, including quilting & sewing Scraps which they sell to 3rd party recyclers. These recycled textiles are used in a variety of industries and are turned into paper, yarn, insulation, audio speakers, carpet padding, upholstery/cushioning and more.

All funds generated through the sale of goods in their stores and their recycling efforts are used to fund the San Diego Adult Rehabilitation Center where 130 men and women participate in a 6+ month program FREE to them.

Drop off your bag of quilting/ sewing scraps at any Salvation Army Donation Trailer, open 7 days a week, 8:30-5:00.


