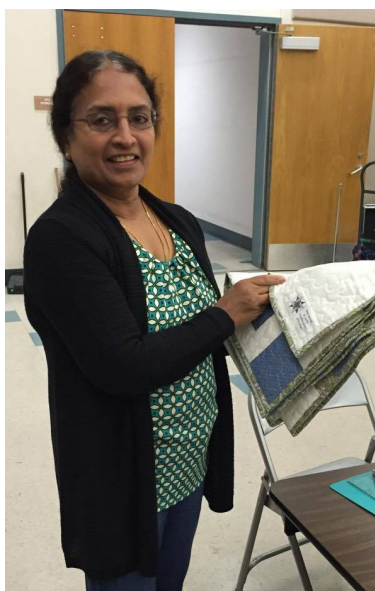
Programs



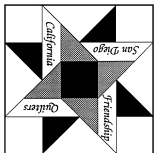
