Requested Recipe!

Pumpkin Chocolate Chip Cookies

Preheat oven to 375.

1 stick butter, room temp.

1/2 cup brown sugar

3/4 cup granulated sugar

3/4 cup Libby's pure pumpkin

1 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract

1 large egg

2 cups flour

1 tea. baking soda

1 tea. salt

1/2 tea. cinnamon

1/2 tea. ginger

1/8 tea. nutmeg

1/8 tea. cloves

2 cups chocolate chips

Beat butter and sugars in a large mixer on medium until well blended, about 5 minutes. In a small bowl (during the 5 minutes) combine flour, baking soda, salt and spices. Add to butter and sugar the pumpkin, egg and vanilla, mix on low. Stir in flour, then chips. Batter will be soft. Drop by tablespoon or small scoop onto ungreased baking sheet about 2" apart.

Bake for 10-12 minutes until edges are firm and lightly browned. Cool for 2 minutes and remove to racks to cool completely.

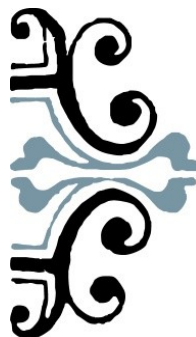

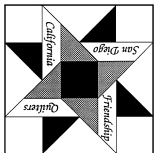
