Philanthropy

Welcome to all new members. Each month you may check out a kit, sew it up, and return it the next month. There's not cost. Placemats, which are donated to Meals on Wheels, seem to be the most popular kit. But, you don't have to check out a kit. You may sew up one of your own designs and donate it to Philanthropy. You may also sew up a quilt top, or create a completed quilt and donate it to Philanthropy.

Small baby quilts go to Life Choices Pregnancy Center. Placemats, wheel chair bags and lap quilts go to Meals on Wheels. Lap size and larger quilts to the Navy Hospital. Small flannel quilts (about 40 x 50) go to Palomar Hospital NICU. Sandra McCullough delivers the Quilts of Valor that are made for the armed services wounded soldiers. Twin size quilts and lap size quilts with juvenile patterns go to Rady Children's Hospital. Quilts of any size go to Soroptimist. Quilts for children, Christmas stockings and toiletries go to St. Clare's Home. Lap size quilts and larger, and flat wheel chair bags go to Veteran's Hospital. Giraffe Isolette covers go to UCSD Hospital.

If you have not fill out a "What I can do" form, please see Hope Campbell at the February meeting. It is very helpful to have this information. Many of our members have long arm quilting machines and enjoy donating time to machine quilt a quilt made by someone else.




