Membership

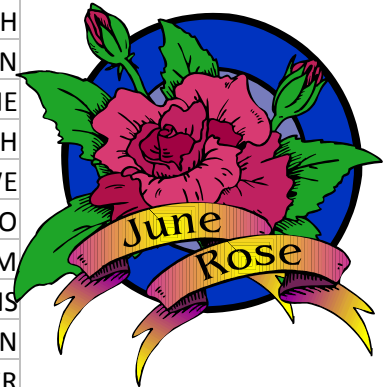
