

We received a total of 24 items: 16 placemats, 5 finished quilts, 2 quilt tops, and 1 pot holder.

# Recipe Corner/Banana Pineapple Ice Box pie from Cheryl Wilson

#### Ingredients:

1 box vanilla wafers (Crushed with rolling pin)

2 (20 ounce) cans bite sized pineapple drained (I also cut into smaller pieces optional)

3to 4 bananas cut into bite size slices (squeeze with lemon juice to keep from browning optional)

1 lg (16 ounce container of whipping cream, e.g. cool whip)

#### OR

 $2\ cups$  heavy whipping cream (and I whip with  $1/2\ cup\$  confectioners' sugar instead of sugar)

1tsp vanilla

#### Directions:

Layer ingredients in 13X9 dish

Cream, vanilla wafers, bananas, pineapple cream save small amount of wafers for top

Cover and place in refrigerator overnight or a couple of hours before serving.

This recipe was my Mother's hence the reference to Ice Box a southern term instead of refrigerator. Other layers could be added such as blueberries, strawberries, or walnuts and graham cracker crumbs instead of vanilla wafers.
