Sheila Groman / Crazy Quilting

Sheila Groman describes her quilts as "original contemporary traditionals." She feels that there is appealing rhythm and symmetry in traditional quilts, while contemporary quilts often are unique and exciting. Her work seems to reflect both areas of quilting: bright, bold color combinations and fresh rhythmic designs.

Her love of nature is evident in her transformation of natural beauty into her landscapes, florals, geometrics, architecture and crazy quilts.

More than fifty articles have been written about her work. They have been in: Quilter's Newsletter Magazine, Lady's Circle Patchwork Quilts, Quilting International, Quilt Almanac, American Quilter, Quilt and Quilting Today.

Her works have been widely exhibited including the AQS exhibit in Paducah, KY and the I.Q.A. exhibit in Houston, TX. They have been awarded over one hundred ribbons including: outstanding accomplishment, viewers' choice, exceptional merit and judge's choice. Her quilts are included in private collections and public buildings.

Sheila earned a B.A. degree from Humboldt State University in CA and a M.Ed. degree from the University of Pittsburgh in PA.

In addition to quilting, she enjoys time spent with family and friends, water color painting, hiking, biking, gardening, reading and yoga.

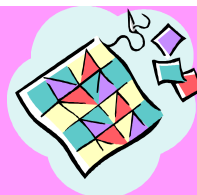

Recipe Corner / Sugar Coated Pecans

Ingredients

- * 1 egg white
- * 1 tablespoon water
- * 1 pound pecan halves
- * 1 cup white sugar
- * 3/4 teaspoon salt
- * 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon



Directions

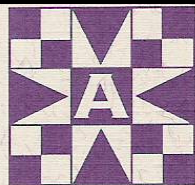
- * Preheat oven to 250 degrees F (120 degrees C). Grease one baking sheet.
- * In a mixing bowl, whip together the egg white and water until frothy. In a separate bowl, mix together sugar, salt, and cinnamon.
- * Add pecans to egg whites, stir to coat the nuts evenly. Remove the nuts, and toss them in the sugar mixture until coated. Spread the nuts out on the prepared baking sheet.
- * Bake at 250 degrees F (120 degrees C) for 1 hour. Stir every 15 minutes.

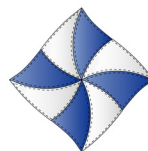

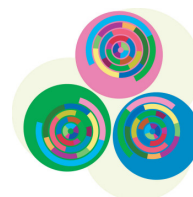
Color Extravagance: Experimenting with Color Border Exchange

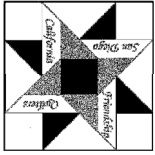
The *Color Extravaganza Border Exchange* is off to a good start!

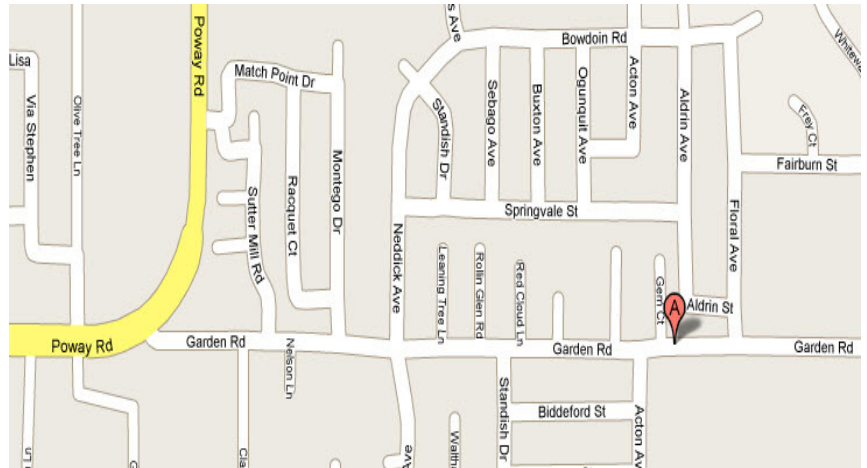
