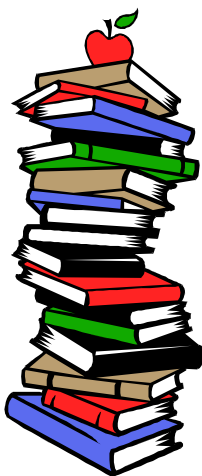
## Library News

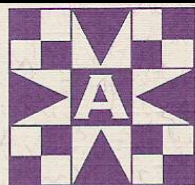

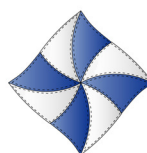

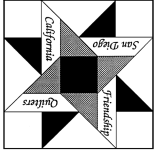
