Are you looking for another opportunity to get together with friends and sew each month? There are two small clubs that meet at Amidon's once a month and there's room for you.



QUILT VISIONS 2004 opened at Oceanside Museum of Art on Saturday, Nov 6, to a crowd of almost 500 guests. There were 22 artists attending, 2 from Japan and 1 from Italy. The exhibition process resembles that of making a quilt. First the entry slides start arriving by mail and everyone gets excited about the wonderful work that the artists are producing. Then the jurors come, and the 45 quilts are selected and we see how the individual pieces combine to make an exhibit. After that, the quilts arrive for the photography process and we admire each one in detail, technique, composition, materials, etc. Finally, these beautiful pieces are carefully arranged on the walls of the museum, lighting installed and the exhibition quilt (the quilt exhibition) is ready for the public. Please come to the exhibit – it is FABULOUS!



Friendship Quilters Guild of San Diego is a non profit corporation organized to educate the community and to promote interest in all forms of quilting. General Guild meetings are held on the second Monday of the month. They are usually held at Tierra Bonita Elementary School, Poway, CA. Annual membership is \$20 from June 1 to May 31 of the following year. At the January meeting, membership dues are reduced to \$10 for the remainder of the fiscal year. Members who are not able to attend meetings or enjoy other benefits of regular membership may pay \$10 per year for a "Newsletter Only" membership, and pay the guest fee (\$5 per meeting) on the occasions when they are able to attend a meeting.
