The Back Country Quilters are putting on their Eight Annual Quilt Show.

On Friday and Saturday, October 19 and 20 at Mountain View Community Church, located at 1191 Meadowlark Way, Ramona (Corner of Hwy. 78 and Ash Streets). The Show hours are 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM both days.

Come spend a fun day in Ramona. October weather is usually perfect for an outing. The Show is free; parking is free. Tickets will be sold for an Opportunity Drawing on a beautiful queen size quilt, a woodsy Log Cabin that would be perfect for Christmas. The drawing will be Saturday before closing. The proceeds of the drawing will go to Ramona worthy causes.

There will be over one hundred quilts beautifully displayed. CDs will be available for sale with all of the quilts pictured. While most members live in Ramona, some come from Poway, Escondido, Santa Ysabel, and Lake Cuyamaca.






