## November Guild Presentation and Workshops With Joen Wolfrom

In other parts of the country, this time of year is

when all the colors come out – don't you just love the change in seasons? Leaves are turning beautiful colors and falling off the trees. The weather is turning colder. Meanwhile, here in the San Diego area, we are still warm, weather-wise. But our colors are coming out, too, as we



get ready to welcome the Color Expert in Quilting, Joen Wolfrom.

Our lecture this month is called: IT'S COLOR THAT MAKES THE QUILTS GO---WOW!!! Take a journey into the world of color, finding clues to basic color ideas and such wonderful illusions as luminosity, luster, depth, shadows, and highlights. Enjoy a slide show parade of eye-catching, show-stopping quilts that go WOW with color as you learn more about the magic of color. (This is a thinking, conceptual idea-based lecture.) This lecture is perfect for all levels of quilters...beginners and all of us who have trouble selecting the right colors and fabrics for our quilts. The lecture begins sharply at 7:00 pm, but come early for a good seat as Joen is a very popular speaker. We will be meeting at Tierra Bonita Elementary School. Enjoy the meeting, look for inspiration, and socialize with other quilters. Two workshops will be presented:

1. "Creative Color Choices" – lecture style half-day workshop. Learn from the color expert and improve your color choices. When: Monday, Nov. 12 (10am – 2pm) at Amidon Quiltworks. Student fee: \$25 (non-members \$5 more).

2. "A Celebration of Color" – lecture style full-day workshop. Are you apprehensive about selecting fabrics for your quilt projects? Learn how easy it is to pick the winning colors and fabrics for your future quilt projects. In this workshop, we'll practice with fabrics, finding the best color combinations to reinforce our learning. When: Tuesday, Nov. 13 (10 am - 4 pm) at Amidon Quiltworks. Student fee: \$45 (non-members \$5 more).

Joen gives quilters this advice: "I think it is wonderful to be as independent as possible in quilt making. Therefore, I am an advocate for every quilter learning how to draft patterns, becoming knowledgeable in design and color basics, and having strong practical sewing and quilting skills. This means taking classes, reading books, and practicing, practicing, practicing. In time, everything comes together naturally."

# Tips and Tricks

Seen on http://www.quiltbug.com/tips.htm — " I sew my label into the seam that sews on the binding. This way, there are only two sides to hand sew and it's more difficult for the label to be removed. I also started put my initials on the seam allowance of the binding. That way, if the quilt disappears and later reappears without the label, I can prove it's mine by simply undoing a few hand stitches."






