Tips and Tricks

I've just started machine quilting in the past year, and I am learning new things all the time. If you're just beginning this journey, you might want to start with monofilament thread, so that stitch length and wobbly lines don't show so much, if at all. Also, speaking of wobbly lines, when you stop to move your hands or readjust fabric, try doing a couple of stitches in place to reorient yourself with the direction you're going before moving on with your design. I always start by machine quilting on a scrap sandwich, too, so that I get into the flow of letting myself relax into the creative motion of quilting.

If you haven't tried machine quilting yet, make a New Year's resolution to give it a go! Start with a small project that's easier to manipulate. Have fun.






