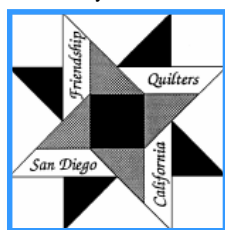

**"Who Says Trees Have To Be Green?"** is the name of the lecture to be presented by Sharyn Craig at our next guild meeting. Sharyn's lecture uses real quilts to introduce an innovative, playful approach to working with color. Sharyn lives in the San Diego area and has been quilting since 1978 and teaching quilting since 1980. She started as an adult education teacher and since then has traveled nationally and internationally teaching and lecturing. Sharyn is also an author of many quilting books and may be best known for encouraging her students to be creative. You no longer have to just follow a pattern; you can make it your own. Sharyn takes the intimidation out of creating your own block settings



and helping with those tricky color choices. Come early to socialize with friends and enjoy the meeting which begins promptly at 7pm, Monday, May 12th at Tierra Bonita Elementary School in Poway. ## Tips and Tricks

If you enjoy scrap quilting as a way of using up your left-over fabric pieces, keep all the left-over lengths of binding. When you have enough saved up, sew them together to make a scrappy binding that's perfect for a scrap quilt. Sometimes I even use this method of making binding for quilts that are not scrap quilts, and only use scrap binding pieces in colors that coordinate with my quilt.

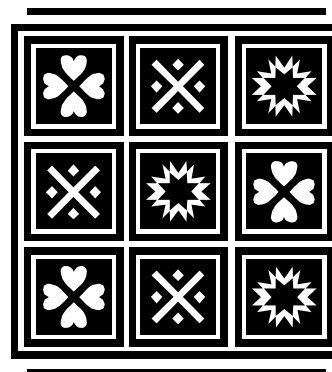

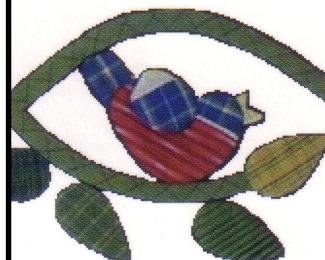

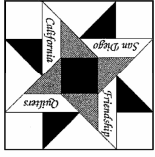
