One tip is to change our needle often, some foreign manufacturing of fabrics use a lot of finishes on fabric. Informal balance is having the center block, off center by having more borders on two sides of the quilt. She uses a lot of different fabrics and says use what ever works for your project. She loves to use flanges around the outer border, and says this is like a mat for a picture. Sylvia taught "Do the Twist" Tuesday at Paradise Sewing. Sylvia talked about working on her PhD, we were all so impressed with her dedication to the quilting world. She is working on Projects Half Done!

This coming month, May 14th Mike McNamara is speaking to us. His lecture is called "Meaning, Metaphor and Humor in Quilt Making". The workshop is the next day, Tuesday May 15th. Please be sure to join us for his lecture and trunk show. Mike likes to be called "Mac", his workshop called "Out-of-the Block Techniques in Machine Piecing" will help us improve our piecing skills.


