### UFO (UnFinished Object) Challenge

2018

Do your unfinished quilting projects haunt you? Do you need a little push to get them done? The UFO Challenge will give you the nudge you need and the satisfaction of a completed project.

- Turn in your UFO entry form and \$10 (that goes towards prizes) to the UFO table.
- Fill out the UFO challenge form with a description of your project. Photocopy, take a photo or fill out a duplicate form for your records.
- You may enter a total of 5 projects, one of which will be philanthropy.
- Each project will have a deadline, however it can be turned in before or after the deadline. If all projects are completed by the deadline you will be entered in a special drawing at the June meeting.
- All projects must be completed when turned in. That includes, quilting, binding and a label with your name and date. Projects without a label will be accepted for philanthropy quilts and placemats.
- Bring your completed projects to the UFO table to be signed off.
- Each time you turn in a project you will get a ticket to enter in the drawing bucket. Also, you will receive a button to sew onto your challenge ribbon. I have more ribbons if you don't already have one.
- The May meeting is the last meeting to turn in your completed projects.

## **Friendship Quilters Quilt Exhibit at the Poway Center for Performing Arts**

### **Show Dates: November 2 - 28, 2018**

Thank you for entering a quilt for the November Quilt Exhibit at the Poway Center for Performing Arts.

To enter a quilt, you must be a paid guild member of Friendship Quilters of San Diego.

Due to limited viewing space, we are limiting one quilt per member.

Accepted quilts for display will be determined by the size of available hanging space.

Your quilt must be submitted by October 8, 2018.

Quilts will be collected at the September guild meeting 09/10, and October guild meeting 10/08.

- A quilt displayed previously at the Poway Center for Performing Arts will not be accepted.
- All quilts entered must be three layers: top, batting, and backing. No tied quilts.
- All quilts must not look aged or worn.
- If a panel is used, it must also contain piecing, applique, or techniques.
- Each quilt must have a label attached to the back.

Quilts that are to be displayed will be authorized by the guild exhibit committee.

Requirements for quilt display:

1. Quilt
2. Quilt label
3. Quilt Sign Tag
4. Labeled wooden slat with eye screws
5. If your quilt is for sale, it will require a sale price. The Poway Center for Performing Arts receives 15% of the sale price.

#### Quilt Sign Tag

This sign will appear near your quilt. Complete the Sign Tag form and submit with your quilt.

Your Sign Tag information will be typed up on card stock for display.

#### Wooden Slat for Hanging

- Each quilt needs a wooden slat for hanging. This should be a flat piece of wood (slat), not a round dowel. Depending on the heaviness of the quilt, this can range from a wooden slat 1/4" thick, 3/8" thick, up to 1/2" thick or so.
- The quilt sleeve should be 3" to 4" wide, and the wooden slat should easily fit inside.
- Each slat must have an eye screw at each end, with equal spacing from edges.

**The slat must have your name, and the quilt name it will be used for.**

Home Depot and Lowes can both cut these slats to the size you need (for a minimal cost). Once attached, the eye screws must not be seen from the quilt front. They should end before the binding.

Pictured are examples of a wooden slat with eye screws.
