


The cost of a triple room is \$253; double room is \$323; and a single is \$430.

Charleen's Corner



If you have ever needed to clean your cutting mat, here is a tip that I recently learned from a pal. Put it in a coolish tub of water with 1/4 C. of vinegar and a squirt of Dawn. Use a soft brush to clean it and rinse with cool water. Dry it with a soft, cotton towel and lay flat. The water softens the mat and makes it easier for the rotary to cut.

And here is something I learned from my sister and I love it! She said to use an orange stick with flat ends as a stiletto to keep your fabric flat as it goes under the needle. I have been doing this for a couple of months and find it to be a very efficient way to ease the fabric and have a nice seam. The wood stick is slanted like a lever and glides under the presser foot without digging into the fabric. Just an idea!
