

Charleen's Corner

This month's corner is a little different. I just had to share some things I have learned from our speaker for May. Her name is Deborah Boschert and she has a lot to say and show about fabric collage. She is an art quilter with lots of articles in "Quilting Arts" magazine.

Don't stop reading yet...you will like this.



She shows us her studio in the June/July 2018 issue, talks about using personal symbols in the December 2018/January 2019 issue and follows that with an offering of options with fabric, paint, and stitch with personal symbols, all using your head, heart and hands.

It's easy and fun. I have been using some of her ideas to make very small quiltlets and have learned so much. Here are some tips:

Focus on a fabric, photo, and/or theme. Collect fabrics that you will use. Include buttons, photos, or other artifacts that please you or tie in with your fabrics and theme. Got old earrings that you don't wear anymore?

Start small and practice. It's a fun break from big quilt projects. And if you don't like them, just toss them. Your product will be something that has meaning for you. Maybe it will inspire you even more to explore your creative side.

Add rubber stamping. Use cardboard tubes for stamping circles on fabric or foam shapes.

Do some decorative stitching. Play around with it.

I hope some of these ideas will inspire you to try some of these ideas. Stay tuned next month for more ideas to make quilting easier.


