# President's Message


Easter has come and gone and the year is moving fast! My Zoom meetings and a few in person charity projects are filling up my schedule again and the weather has been gorgeous.

# Philanthropy News

Greetings, quilting friends. I just had the best experience delivering SEVENTEEN quilts for the immigrant girls at the convention center. A few were from personal friends of mine (and my own) but I am so grateful to all of you who contributed quilts to this worthy cause! I assume they will be wanting more, since there are so many girls, so please keep them coming!

I have many quilt kits ready to be quilted. They do not require fancy free-motion quilting, if that is something that is not your forte. Simple stitch-in-the-ditch would be great.

I am sharing here the link to an old newsletter in which I gave directions for a Warm Wishes quilt. This is my "go to" pattern when I need to make one quickly. I can get the top cut out and assembled in less than three hours, i.e. a morning, and then quilted in the afternoon.

I can still use a few more earth-tone squares or pastel stars in order to have enough to make the quilts. They should be 12 1/2", i.e. 12" finished. Just a square or two from each of you would be absolutely wonderful! Thank you for all you do!

### Quilt Instructions - Warm Wishes

7.5" square

Cut 5 - 7.5" wide strips selvage to selvage.
Cut: 7.5 " squares out of the strips.

Color A
Color B
Color C

Cut: 5 - 2.75" strips each of Color A and Color C fabric from selvage to selvage.

Cut: 5 - 3" strips of Color B fabric from selvage to selvage. Sew them together as shown. Squares should be 7.5".

Sew the squares together alternating solid squares with striped squares and alternating the colors to make frames around the squares of every other row. Iron rows towards the dark fabric.

Lay the pieces out on a table or floor, making sure that the striped squares are alternated by color. Then sew the rows together.

Your quilt top should look like the photo.
