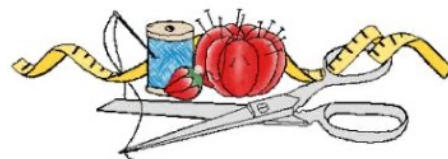
End of Year Party

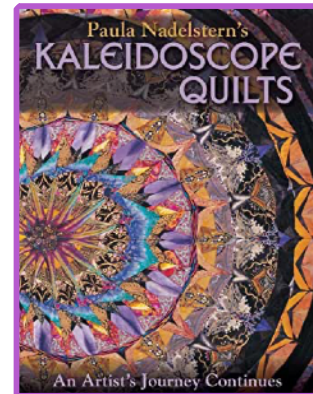

Nifty Quilting Tips

Place 3 cutting mats side by side on your sewing table with machine placed on top of the middle one. This allows you to trim pieces on either side of the machine while sewing. Just move the machine off the mats to get more cutting area.

Only buy fabric you love, because you will save every scrap and your creativity will be sparked to use it in new ways.

Use a bamboo skewer or chopstick instead of a stiletto. It causes less damage to needles and is easily replaced.
