
## **PROGRAMS**

Hi-I am Laura Martin and I am the Programs Chair along with Karen Schwartz for this coming guild year. We are excited to finally be able to meet in person again. Because of all the uncertainty about things opening up with the pandemic our Fall Presenters will all be virtual. However, the guild will be meeting in person. Our new venue has a large pull down screen and two large tv monitors that we will project our program onto. Members who want to watch from home will be able to do that as well.

In the Spring we surveyed the guild about workshops. Overwhelmingly, the members stated that they wanted workshops to continue. In order to continue having workshops we need everyone's help in signing up early. Workshops are not fund raisers for the guild. The cost is there to cover the expenses of the workshop. It takes about 16 attendees to break even. So please sign up for the workshops and sign up early. Workshops are \$45 for guild members and \$55 for non-members. We will open spots for guild members first and then open it up to the general public. We will only have four workshops scheduled for this year. If we do not have enough sign-ups 30 days prior to a workshop being held then we will have to cancel the workshop. Our Fall workshops will be held virtually as well. Each of these workshops will be on two days, a week apart, for 3 hours each day.

## September

Our September Speaker is Rhonda Pierce of Schmetz Needles. Her talk is entitled "What Needle Should I Use?" She will be talking about the most important 2" piece of steel in the sewing machine. Rhonda's classes are filled with "A Ha" moments and giggles as you learn about needle facts. She is the Spokesperson for Schmetz Needles North America and Vice President of Euro-Notions. She publishes the e-zine "Schmetz Inspired to Sew", she is a certified FitNice System Instructor, and earned the Brendon Burchard High Performance



Certificate. Her last quilt "Color Splash" was displayed at three international quilt festivals. There will be no workshop for September.

#### October

In the October Guild Meeting we will have Sarah Goer of Sarah Goer Quilts coming to do a lecture/demo entitled "Creating A Scrappy Slab". Get your scraps out of your scrap bin and into a project. Sarah will demonstrate her technique for building a "scrappy slab" from scrap fabrics of any size. She will show us numerous ways to use these in projects and quilts.



Sarah's Workshop is titled "Improv Log Cabins". This is your opportunity to try a new spin on the traditional log cabin block. You can choose small or large-scale. Play with size of strips, background, placement, symmetry, and other elements to create your own unique improv log cabin. The Improv Log Cabin Workshop will be on Saturday Oct. 16th & 23rd from 9am to noon on Zoom. The workshop costs \$45 for members and \$55 for non-members.
