Friendship is delighted to welcome our November Speaker Marjan Kleupfel, an artist who uses fabric and thread as her medium instead of paper and paint, and a sewing machine instead of a brush.

Marjan will speak to us about how the texture of the fabric is an important design element in her work and how she incorporates many different surface design techniques, such as iridescent Angelina fibers, fabric dyeing, painting, printing, pleating, machine quilting, and embroidery in her work.

After growing up in the Netherlands and living in Florida, Hawaii, South Carolina and Australia, she draws inspiration for her art from all of these places, both on land and under water.

Marjan will also be holding a workshop on Tuesday, November 14, at 10:00 a.m., where you can create one of two beautiful dragonfly wall quilts and learn how to add sparkle with iridescent Angelina fibers, foiling and machine embroidery threads.





This is a fast and fun technique suitable for new and experienced quilters. Learn about the many exciting ways you can utilize Angelina fibers.

A kit with several colors of Angelina fiber is available for \$5 and the pattern is \$10. Please contact Karen Schwartz if you would like to attend or have any questions. Space is limited!





Thank you to all who joined the pincushion swap for October. We had twelve pincushions and they were all so creative. I did not get pictures of each pincushion – for those who received one, if you would like to send a picture of your new pincushion, please send it to me at my email address on the member roster. I will share them in an upcoming newsletter.

To celebrate Autumn, for our November meeting we will exchange pumpkins: stuffed fabric pumpkins, wool pumpkin banners, foundation paper-pieced pumpkin mug rug or small pillow, or a pumpkin block wall hanging. Nothing too big – blocks, banners, or pillows no bigger than 10-12 inches. Have fun with your pumpkin's colors: black and white, blue floral, purple batik, and of course, all shades of orange! Looking for inspiration--Pinterest has some great ideas!

I will also have a sign-up sheet for a loot bag exchange for our January meeting. This will be a partner-paired exchange. For this swap, each participant will sew a zippered pouch (dimensions approximately 7-8" tall, by 10-11" wide by 2" deep, and be given the name of another Guild member to sew for. After the pouch is sewn, please fill it with a favorite quilting tool, a scrap of a favorite fabric or two, and a quilting tip or two that you have found helpful in your quilting journey. There are websites that have free patterns for making zippered pouches, so no pattern needs to be purchased to take part in the exchange.

If you have any ideas for future swaps, I would love to hear them.
