
No Sit & Sews in December are Scheduled

For our next swap, we will be partnering together with a quilting friend to make and exchange Loot Bags. This swap has been extended until February to allow enough time complete the pouch, as December is so busy with holiday preparations.

Each participant will sew a zippered pouch (approximately 7-8" tall by 9-10" wide), fill it with a yard of a new quilt-store quality fabric, and include a favorite sewing/quilting tool, and share your favorite quilting tip.

You will be paired up with another guild member, and after signups close I will send you your partner's name and email address. You can talk together about your favorite colors (and any other quilty information about yourself). You will then bring your finished pouch to the February guild meeting for your assigned guild partner.

There are many free patterns and tutorials online to help you with making the pouch. Moda Fabrics has sponsored a monthly pouch sew-along on their blog this year with free patterns. You can find it here: Moda Pouch Club

One of my favorites is Sotak Handmade on YouTube—she has a great video for shortening nylon zippers and making zipper tabs to give a really neat finish to your bag: <u>How to Shorten a Zipper and add Fabric Tabs for a Professional Finish</u>.
