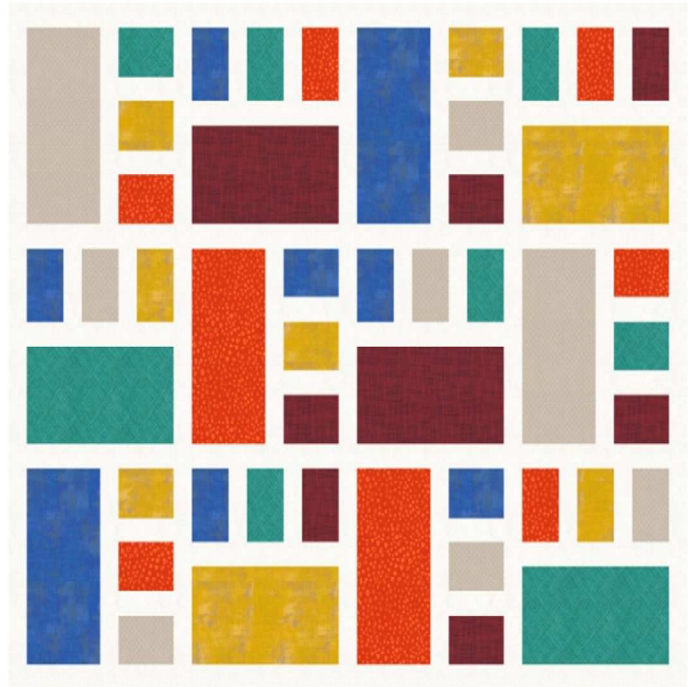
*No Sit & Sews in December are Scheduled*



Each participant will sew a zippered pouch (approximately 7-8" tall by 9-10" wide), fill it with a yard of a new quilt-store quality fabric, and include a favorite sewing/quilting tool, and share your favorite quilting tip.

You can talk together about your favorite colors (and any other quilty information about yourself). You will then bring your finished pouch to the February guild meeting for your assigned guild partner.

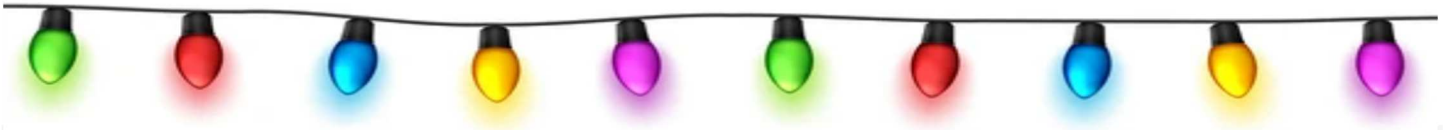

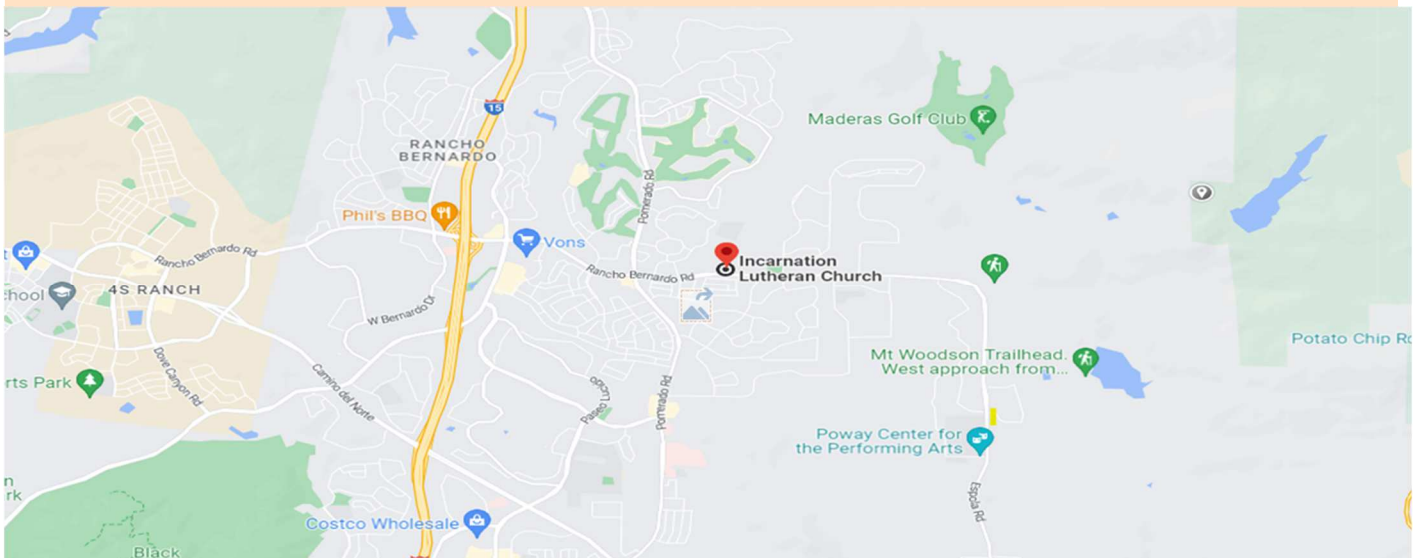

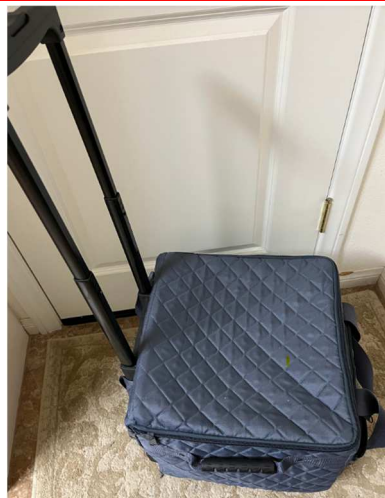
