Jenny Lyon, a well known C & T author and award winning art quilter, will be joining us on Zoom this month. Jenny spends her time lecturing and teaching the art of quilting on a home machine and inspires quilters to do their best work. She has created an on-demand course for learning to free motion quilt on a domestic machine.

Jenny teaches at guilds, shops, events and international shows. She calls some of her classes "Fearless" and says the biggest barrier to successful free motion quilting is our internal critical voice. If you can let go of that, you can successfully free motion quilt.

Jenny uses a domestic machine to create art quilts and wearable art. She calls herself the *Quilt Skipper* because while working on a whole cloth quilt and loving how the quilt was shaping up, she began cheerfully *skipping* around the house!

Jenny's work has been juried at a variety of major shows, to include Houston and Paducah, Her work is also shown in several art galleries and SAQA exhibits.






