Catherine has been quilting since she was in high school and began designing quilts in her twenties. Catherine says that she never planned on being a designer or having a quilt-based

business, but that's the direction her life seemed to take...and says she "wouldn't have it any other way!"

Catherine loves traditional piecing with a modern edge, reinterpreting old quilt blocks with new fabrics, or old fabrics in modern settings. Her family and friends say that she has "Quilting ADD," but who can blame her? There are just so many quilts, styles and colors to design, make and enjoy.

President's Message

Karla Seyb-Stockton—President

I just got home from the Road To California Quilter's Conference & Showcase, and I will tell you, I was so jazzed up I could hardly sleep last night! I took a walking foot quilting class yesterday. I have so many ideas for how I am going to quilt my unfinished projects! (And it is a good thing, because one of them is due in February in our Just Get it Done challenge!) I saw so many pretty quilts. Being in the presence of so much creativity, I hope that some rubbed off on me. But maybe the best part of the three days I was up there was volunteering at the Southern California Council of Quilt Guilds booth collecting donations for the fire survivors. The plan had originally been for their booth to serve as a collection point for donations for the Mountain Fire that was in November in the Ventura County communities of Camarillo and Somis. Then the big fires happened and there was so very much need and the quilting community stepped up. The quilts will be offered to the individuals whose homes were destroyed or uninhabitable because of damage. Each member of the household gets to choose their own, and Matt Reese, the CEO of Road to California has offered to store the quilts in his warehouse, until they can be sorted and distributed at resource fairs for the fire survivors. Those impacted by the Palisades and Eaton fires are, for the most part, still too unsettled to be ready to receive a quilt, but when they are ready, the hope is that there will be a quilt for them. That means there will be a need for quilts for the next couple of years, because some won't be ready until they are ready to move back into their rebuilt house. I was gratified to take six quilts from our guild. Three were philanthropy quilts that had yet to be distributed and three were from individual donors. Thank you for that. And I will say this— If you make a quilt to give, I will make sure it gets to where it needs to go.

Now, onto other matters. I am making good progress on my "Books and Blocks" quilt. I hope you are making one too. There is no size requirement. You can make anything from mug rug or placemat size up to a bed sized quilt. It is up to you. It is also up to you how you interpret the theme of "Books and Blocks." I can tell you mine has morphed a little from when I was first thinking about it last summer. I will at least have the top done (my Just Get it Done quilt has first priority), and I can hardly wait to show it to you at the meeting!

And I am really excited about the February program and workshop with Catherine Wilson. Our class was full so we moved it to the Creative Coop in Ramona so everyone could be included. As of this writing, we have two open spaces in the class. Is learning Foundation Paper Piecing the Judy Way something that might challenge or inspire you? I will assure you one thing... when I got the jury summons for THE VERY DAY OF THE CLASS my first thought was "Oh good grief, why is the universe against me?!?" But my second thought was, "Oh, I can change this to a week later and it will be just fine." Needless to say, my civic duties have been rescheduled.

So wherever you are, I hope you are jazzed up about the projects and opportunities that lie ahead of you. Remember Quilty Pleasures, Sew Hungry, Philanthropy Sit 'n Sews, small groups and of course the guild meetings and workshops. I'll see you around, I hope.


