On the topic of finishing, did you make any quilting resolutions at the New Year? This is to be my year to finish... And that is important, because I am a good quilt starter, but not such a good finisher! I knew I was going to be taking the two classes the guild has scheduled this Spring, but other than those, my mantra was FINISH, FINISH, FINISH! So what did I do on vacation? I fell in the Brown Bag Mystery hole. My sisters had talked about it earlier in the Spring, and my younger sister who had just retired the month before, decided she was going to jump into the BBM as her retirement gift to herself. I had never heard of the Brown Bag Mystery. Come to find out it is a rather big deal across the country (though not here in California... not one quilt shop in CA is participating). I planned to cheer her on from afar... but what did I find while on vacation helping my friend pick out a new sewing machine? We stopped at The Cactus Quilt Shop in Tucson where she lives. (If you aren't familiar with a brown bag mystery, all the fabric for a quilt top is in a brown bag, and a two inch strip of the focus fabric is displayed on the outside. Of course the bag is stapled shut, so there is no telling where the fabric picker is going with that focus fabric.) Each shop—there are dozens across the US and Canada—curates their own fabric bags. Of course one caught my eye. It is red chili peppers and the bag was called Tucson Chilis #2. Oh! That seemed like the perfect souvenir to take home! I have never been good at sticking to my resolutions! And just to tell you how much of a good starter I am, I decided to make a scrappy version from my stash (I have so many lovely scraps from the Susan Prioleau sale we had last year. I love all those little pieces!) right along with the store version! Now Clue 1 and Clue 2 have come out and it is my pledge to not let this project become an unfinished project! I am really looking forward to being able to show them both to you later this year! Hold me to it! Ask me about it as the weeks go by. The last clue comes out May 10, so my goal will be to have them quilted ready to show you at the September meeting!

I am also looking forward to our April program. Kim Oleson will teach us about the process of ice dying. It makes such beautiful fabric. I am excited to learn how it is done.

I am likewise excited about our End of Year Party at the Hamburger Factory ON OUR REGULAR MEETING NIGHT, Monday, June 9 at 6:30pm! Visitors and members alike anticipate an interesting adventure during our July 4th Quilt Show in Old Town Poway every year. The quilts are always inspiring and fun to see! Watching a guild member sewing or demonstrating quilting techniques in person is a real highlight of the show!

- The cool room is a sweet respite from the summer heat!
- It's your turn to show your stuff! Demonstrate solo, or join a quilting buddy to sew, quilt, foundation-piece, free-motion quilt, etc. Explain a quilt processes such as:
 - Differences between a tied comforter and a quilt,
 - Quilt sandwich layers (top, batting, backing),
 - quilting stitch examples – machine, hand, big-stitch, etc.,
 - Applique versus piecing,
 - Cutting tools display (scissors, templates, rotary cutter, cutting mat, rulers etc.),
 - Demonstrate the AccuQuilt cutter and various dies – show small samples of quilts made with these shapes,
 - How to make a puff quilt,

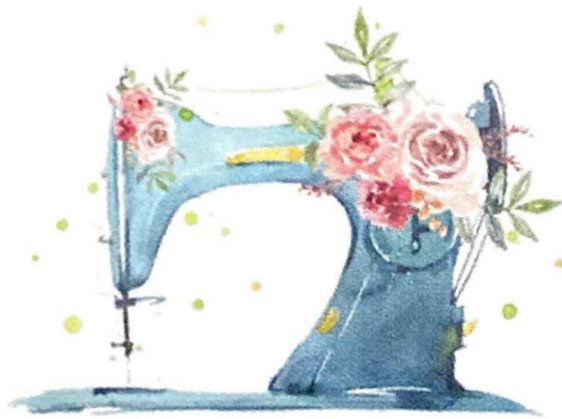

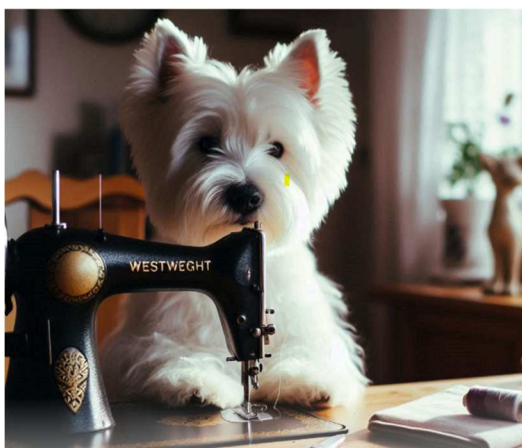

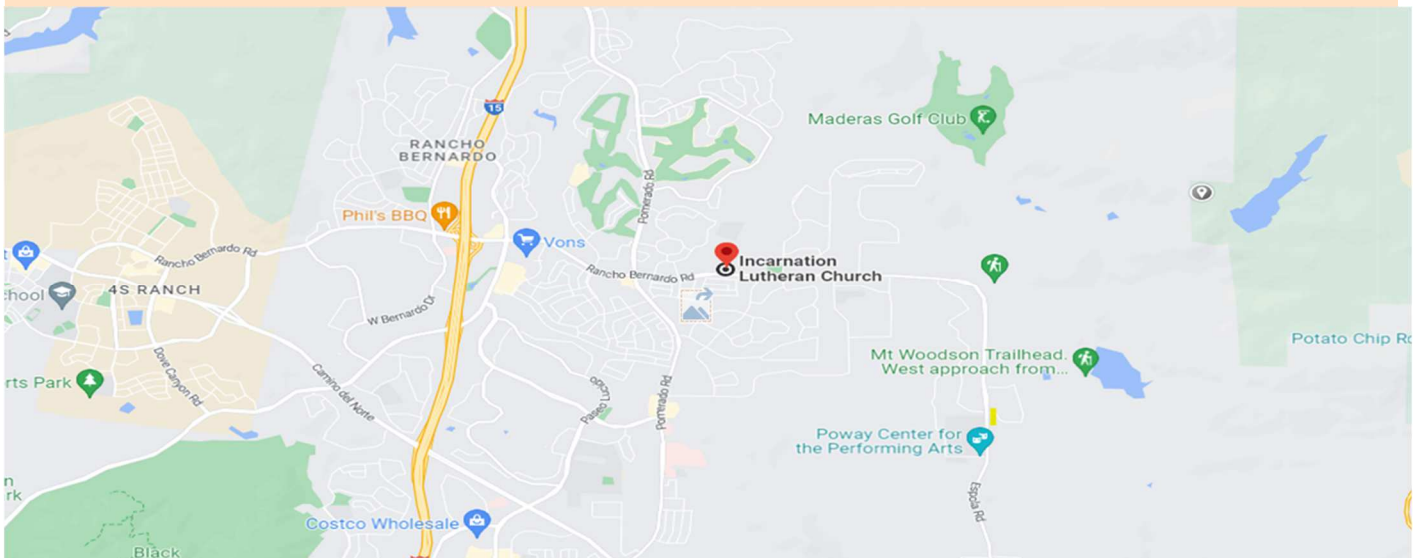
