I love putting colors together and yet, I think I have a lot to learn in that regard.

At the April meeting, I took an informal poll about the possibility of doing a President's Challenge Mystery Quilt next fall. There was enough positive feedback, I have done some thinking about it... and my preliminary plans are as follows:

- * This will be a quilt from your stash sew-along;
- * I will pick a pattern—beginner friendly but not TOO easy;
- * You will pick fabrics from your stash. If you must, you may buy ONE fabric only;
- * I will give you guidance as to how much fabric you will need; 'light, medium, dark and background'. (If you need more than one color in one of those categories, I will make that clear.);
- * I will give the written clues each month starting in October, how many months it will be depends on the pattern; and
- * You are welcome to make two and give one to Philanthropy!

I am open to suggestions as to how to organize and run the mystery. Let me know if you have any thoughts about that.

Watching a guild member, sewing or demonstrating quilting techniques in person is a real highlight of the show!

- Differences between a tied comforter and a quilt,
- Quilt sandwich layers (top, batting, backing),

- Cutting tools display (scissors, templates, rotary cutter, cutting mat, rulers etc.)
- Demonstrate AccuQuilt cutter and various dies – show small samples of quilts made with these shapes
- How to make a puff quilt
