




Iron and pad if you have a small one

Bring scraps, some quarter yard cuts, some fat quarters, a few neutrals (I always include a few blacks, dark grays), but mostly just fabrics you love, ones that make you smile. I like to have at least 12-14 fabrics.

Bring a chunk of batting 27x27" and a ¾ yard backing and your walking foot, just in case you get to the quilting stage.


