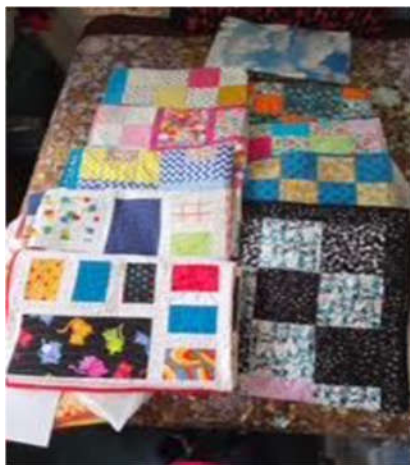
Report from Candy Mittag

Turned in at April's meeting were 25 finished pillowcases, one finished quilt and one quilt top. They will be delivered after sorting for different age groups.

We delivered 8 adult quilts to Elizabeth Hospice and 9 children's quilts to Project Linus during the first week of April.

Sizes for Project Linus Quilts tend to run on the smaller side than other organizations and are for kids 0-18. Baby quilts are 30x36 up to 40x40. Most quilts are 40x60 or up

to a twin size for the older teens. The kit quilts we have been making from Sue Mezera's pattern is normally too large for them but when Ursula (our Project Linus Contact), was holding it up, she was excited that they were perfect for the teens, so we have a nice outlet for the children's kits and Elizabeth Hospice loved the adult version of the kits.
