

MAKING FACES TWO

SUPPLIES LIST**

Pattern fee - \$10

FABRICS

These are bare minimums and are enough to make a quilt similar to the sample. Larger hair styles, clothing, and different totems will need more fabric. I have used mainly batiks.

BACKGROUND

One Fat Quarter, not too busy.

FACE

Two rectangles, 8" x 4". Should contrast well with the background.

BODY

15" x 10". Can be the same as one of your face choices.

HAIR

7" x 9". For longer or wider hair you will need about 9" x 12"

FACE ELEMENTS (small pieces)

2" x 4.5" Black (eyes and mouth)

2" x 2" (lips) color is up to you

3"x3" White (eye highlight and eyeball)

PERSONAL TOTEM

Cup- 4"x 4", Saucer – 2" x 6"

I will have templates available for a cat, a bird and a teapot. Bring the appropriate selection of scrap pieces.

BORDERS

Inner Border - four 1 ½" strips

Outer Border – four 3" strips.

All fabrics, other than the background and borders, *must be backed in Wonder Under.*

In addition to a sewing machine in good working order, please bring fabric scissors, paper scissors, neutral thread, additional machine needles, small embroidery scissors (optional), #2 pencil, rotary cutter, mat and ruler plus anything else that will make your sewing experience a good one.
