President's Message

Karla Seyb-Stockton—President

Hello Friendship Quilters!

By now it is too late to sign up for the party on June 8, so I hope you already did. It wouldn't be as fun without you! We are going to have some good food, time for catching up, play a game or two, win some prizes, celebrate the volunteers that make our guild great, and give away that awesome Susan's Garden opportunity quilt. Assuming you are signed up, remember it starts promptly at 6:30, so come a little earlier to get settled in and get a good seat. We have access to the room at 6:00 pm to set up and get organized.

To change the subject, but only a little, I am reading a very interesting book called "The Fabric of Civilization: How Textiles Made the World" by Virginia Postrel. She makes the case that while the stone age was the beginning of civilization, it should rather be called the string and stone age. The fibers that were twisted into strong string is actually what held the stone to the handle of rudimentary axes and hoes, constructed the sling shot, covered their bodies much more comfortably than the skins had done. She writes,

We hairless apes coevolved with our cloth. From the moment we're wrapped in a blanket at birth, we are surrounded by textiles. They cover our bodies, bedeck our beds, and carpet our floors. Textiles give us seat belts and sofa cushions, tents and bath towels, medical masks and duct tape. They are everywhere.

And aren't we the better off for it.

If you are like me, just having the utilitarian fabrics are not enough. I also just like to look at and touch my fabrics. I like to sort my scraps. I like to cut them into little pieces and sew them back together better. I need to make pretty things. But the language of fabric is also fun. Once again, to quote Virginia Postrel, "

We drag out our heirloom metaphors—"on tenterhooks," "tow-headed," "frazzled"—with no idea that we're talking about fabric and fibers. We repeat threadbare clichés: "whole cloth," "hanging by a thread," "dyed in the wool." We catch airline shuttles, weave through traffic, follow comment threads. We speak of life spans and spinoffs and never wonder why drawing out fibers and twirling them into thread looms so large in our language. Surrounded by textiles, we're largely oblivious to their existence and to the knowledge and efforts embodied in every scrap of fabric.

I think it is so fun to consider how this medium that we love has made such an impact on our lives and our language.

So happy quilting my friends, and never hesitate to use a good fabric metaphor.
